#### **Adverse Weather Arrangements/School Closure**

With the adverse weather at the start of last week, I thought it would be worthwhile sharing information about school procedures in the event of the need to close. If school was unable to open, we would notify parents as early as possible (and before 8am) via text message and then follow up with a phone call to between 9am and 10am from the class teacher to discuss activities

to be completed and suggest different strategies and techniques which may be implemented to help complete these. The activities would be simple, could be completed at home and may link directly to your child's EHCP.

#### **Names in Clothes**

Could we please ask that you check that all of your children's clothes have their names in, including hats, scarves and gloves. We are getting quite a bit of lost property which is unnamed. If you are missing anything please let staff know and we will try to get it back to you.

#### Milk

We have been researching how to provide milk for the children in school as part of our healthy school offer. From January if your child receives pupil premium funding they will be entitled to daily milk as part of this. For those children who are not in receipt of pupil premium funding there will be the option to register to have this as an option as well. The cost we have managed to secure is incredibly low at 28p per day (£1.40 per week). Tina will be sending further details and information about this next week.


