What have our Busy Bees been learning this month?

Hive 1

It's been wonderful to welcome the children into Hive 1. We have two new starters, who are happy and settled already ① This month, our topic is *Home Sweet Home* and we are exploring what happens in all the different rooms. We continue to learn Maths through songs and play and practise our writing in mark-making.

Hive 2

We are delighted with how the children have settled back into their routines and learning. We have started our new topic, "Me and My Family" and have been thinking about things we like and that are important to us. We have also created some super self-portraits using oil pastels. In Maths we have been sorting objects using different criteria and have enjoyed singing the *Sorting Song*. We have also been using ten frames to help us with our counting. In Phonics we are continuing practising letter recognition and formation.

Hive 3

This month in Hive 3 we have settled in well and welcomed 3 new members to our Hive. We have continued looking at writing in sentences, working to become more independent and able to check ourselves if we have got all of the elements right. Maths has been about place value and counting, some of us are learning to use a 10s frame, some are looking at breaking numbers into 10s and 1s and some are expanding that even further to 100s 10s and 1s. We have loved our topic learning so far what a human needs versus wants and the positive effects of a healthy diet and exercise.

Hunningley - Lewis

This week we have been doing some amazing work around The Three Little Pigs story. We have been building straw, stick and brick houses just like in our story and labelling them. In Maths we have been learning through a variety of songs, focusing on counting and adding. With this being our first full week in our new school, we have been meeting our new class and our new teachers. We have been making new friends and learning new ways to get to school.

Hunningley – Simon

We have settled in fantastically to a new class in a new school. During our lessons we have been looking at a football mystery in Maths. In English we have completed a reading exercise and started writing about this. Our science has been looking at solids, liquids and gases and how they change from one to another. During choosing time some of the children love to make models whilst others play Maths on the games Smartboard.
