
World Book Day



At the end of last half term, we completed our Saxons and Vikings topic after learning many things about housing, farming and the Saxon way of life. We looked in detail at the Vikings and how they attacked Britain, and how their rule ended. We made shields and Viking longboats as part of our Art curriculum.

In Maths, we continued to look at fractions, with some of the children progressing to decimals and percentages. We also wrote a letter to the police about the Demon Dentist and her wicked ways!

This half term we have lots more exciting tasks planned as part of our Potions topic. We will be making potions in Science, making perfume bottles in Art and writing the next chapter of George's Marvelous Medicine. Last half term we loved taking part in lots of scientific experiments where we created the sun, moon and earth. We used these planets in an experiment to learn about day and night. We used torches to beam light from the sun towards our planet. In RE we explored Chinese New Year.

This half term we are learning all about Dinosaurs! We are really looking forward to our archaeological dig this week, where we are going to pretend to be archaeologists searching for bones of different kinds of dinosaurs. We are

focusing on learning about adaptations that certain dinosaurs had and how this helped them thrive for so long.

In addition, we are going to learn all about number lines in our Maths lessons. We are also going to keep working on counting to 20. In our phonics lessons we are working hard to blend sounds together to read CVC words and identify tricky words.


