Hive 1

This half term, the children have been busy exploring a wide range of learning across the curriculum. In Maths, we have focused on comparing amounts, using the language of more, fewer and equal to, and learning the symbols that help us show these comparisons. In Phonics, children have been building their blending skills, using pure sounds to recognise letters and read simple words with increasing confidence. Our Topic work has centred on light and dark: we have different investigated light sources, discussed why light is important, and experimented with how shadows are made — noticing how they can change size depending on the position of the light. In RE, we have learned about Diwali, the celebration of light, and the children have enjoyed listening to traditional music, exploring aspects of the festival, making Diwali candle holders and creating their own mehndi patterns.
